

JMA Journal Achieves Its First Journal Impact Factor

- Aiming for Continued Growth as a Premier General Medical Journal –



The JMA Journal, an English-language online publication by the Japan Medical Association in collaboration with the Japanese Association of Medical Sciences, has attained its first Journal Impact Factor (JIF) of 1.5, as announced by Clarivate on June 20, 2024. This achievement is expected to enhance the journal's visibility and attract greater international attention through databases such as the "Web of Science," utilized by researchers worldwide.

Since its launch in September 2018, the JMA Journal has established itself as a comprehensive general medical journal. It welcomes a diverse range of submissions, including clinical medicine, basic medicine, public health, and healthcare policy, as well as opinions on topics beyond clinical medicine. Full-text access to all published articles is available on the official JMA Journal website.

For the time being, there are no fees for submission, publication, or open access.

In alignment with its commitment to advancing medical knowledge, the journal is currently focusing on medical AI. Contributions from leading experts are solicited for review articles, and submissions from researchers in this field are actively encouraged. Accepted papers on medical AI will be published sequentially.

The JMA Journal remains dedicated to serving as a trusted resource for medical researchers and healthcare professionals. The journal will continue to enhance the quality of its publications and contribute meaningfully to global medicine and healthcare.
